FOLDING SCOOTERS AND 3 WHEELED SCOOTERS ARE NOT PERMITTED EXCEPT FOR WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY MINI SHREDDER SESSION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Rush is a skatepark and not a playground and therefore should be treated with respect. Please consider other users and be aware of your surroundings at all times and attend a session that is appropriate for your experience level. The rules for an open session are very different to that of a beginner's session. PARENTS ARE NO LONGER PERMITTED TO VIEW FROM THE STREET SECTION DURING OPEN SESSIONS.

FOLDING SCOOTERS, THREE WHEELED SCOOTERS AND V SCOOTERS ARE NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE SKATEPARK EXCEPT FOR THE U5 MINI SHREDDER SESSION.

It is compulsory for riders U18 to wear a helmet in all sessions. It is also compulsory for ALL riders to wear a helmet on the jump track, resi and foam pit areas.

MINI SHREDDERS – This is a session for U5s pre school children/toddlers. This session is held in the Street Section and three wheeled scooters are permitted. (Wednesday and Friday only). Please refrain from sliding down the ramps.

BEGINNERS – Street and park section only. Limited to 75 riders. Open to complete beginners aged 5 years and over. We recommend this session for those riders that have never visited an indoor Skatepark or are inexperienced. The smallest drop in is around 4ft and the largest 9ft. If a rider is found to be too experienced they will be asked to leave this session without refund. Pre-booking is essential for this session during the winter months and on wet days.

After School Club – The whole park is open including the foam pit/resi and jump track. We advise pre-booking for this session. Primarily for U16s but at the discretion of the management of Rush Skatepark we may allow older/experienced riders in depending on how busy the session is. Children must be 5 years and over to attend.

Open Sessions – The whole park is open including the foam pit/resi and jump track. We advise pre-booking for this session. Parents are no longer permitted to view from the street section during open sessions. **This session is for the more competent rider and therefore we do not advise beginners or very young children attend.** If a rider is found to be inexperienced they will be asked to leave without refund.

Due to the age of the building it is likely that there may be damp patches and condensation that appear on the ramps or within the street section. On some occasions we may have to close the street section at short notice or during a session and this area will remain closed until it is safe for riders to use.

The above hours are subject to change and you should consult the website before travelling (for those customers who use Smart Phones we advise you refresh the Rush website every week).

It will be at Rush Skatepark's discretion as to the ability and experience of anyone under the age of 12 wishing to ride the park after 6.30pm weekdays.

Refunds will be NOT be made for "no show", late entry (other than that which has been caused by Rush Skatepark) or for leaving a session before the end. Exceptional circumstances may apply and will be at management discretion.
